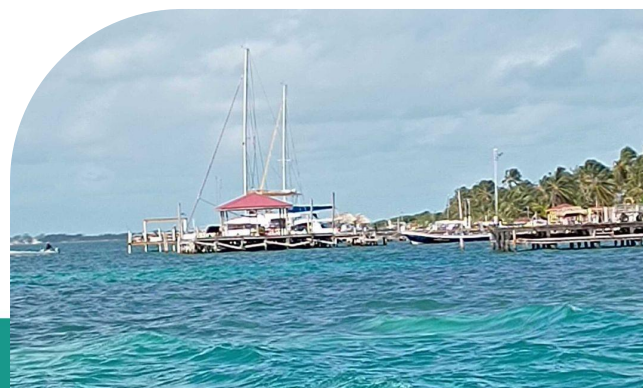
SAMPLE PROGRAM ITINERARY

DAY 1: BELIZE CITY ARRIVAL, SAN IGNACIO ORIENTATION & EXPLORATION

- Faculty travel to Belize City where they are greeted by our staff at the airport and transported 2 hours to a hotel near the town of San Ignacio.
- Welcome dinner and orientation with Country Director and In-Country Team.

DAY 2: VISIT PARTNER COMMUNITIES, MEET LOCAL PROFESSIONALS + EXPERIENCE BELIZE

- Breakfast & Professional Development Workshops at the hotel.
- Visit partner communities. Get introduced to local culture and understand the health and social environment of the country.
- Enjoy a delicious lunch!
- Visit Mayan Ruins and cultural activities in the region.
- Dinner and Evening Presentations and Reflections





DAY 3: TRANSPORT TO SOUTHERN STANN CREEK DISTRICT, EXPLORE COMMUNITIES AND PROJECTS

- Early transport to southern region and local communities
- Visit partner communities. Get introduced to local culture and understand the health and social environment of the country.
- Maya Center lunch and cultural activities
- Further community visits, lodging facilities, and cultural activities
- Final celebratory dinner and reflections

DAY 4: PROGRAM CLOSURE AND BELIZE DEPARTURE

- Transport provided from hotel to the airport departures

Who is invited on a Site Visit?

Any High School faculty, administrators, and/or adult club leaders from across the country who are interested in and serious about offering a Squads Abroad volunteer travel program at their school in the future!

Where do we stay during a Site Visit?

Faculty stay in our nice partner 'homebase' hotel facilities throughout the program. Double rooms with private bath are provided by default and options to upgrade to individual rooms are provided upon availability at our facilities.

Is there a cost to participate in an international Site Visit?

The Professional Development Fee of \$800 includes airfare (up to \$1000) and all in-country expenses including food, lodging, transport, and advertised activities. Professional Development Fees are made in the form of a 'donation' to our 501c3 non-profit on behalf of the registered participant.
